SCHOOL ADMIN REPORT & AD REPORT (Paul Fahrner)

- Winter Sports have started
- Compliments received about banners in gym
- 1st basketball game had good turnout, 285 paid admissions which does not include season passholders, approx crowd 320
- New dirt being put down for baseball & softball fields
- Study hall – all athletes are required to attend unless they have a 3.25 min GPA and a note from parents. Study hall will be 2 hrs/wk – coaches make their own schedules. Duke Owen to work with Paul to get clarified requirements for exceptions out to Parent Reps.
- Approximately 10 of 303 (3%) fall student athletes will not be eligible for Winter sports.
- Coaches are responsible for arranging buses to games. No buses to practices.
