The Rockville High School Booster Club recently completed their 2007-2008 school year's activities with the close of their fiscal year on June 30th, 2008. The club mission is to "advance the role extracurricular activities play in the development and well being our students. Our goals are to promote our students' academic and athletic success, promote a positive image of Rockville High School, and to provide a safe place for parents, school staff and students to support the school's extracurricular activities. We support school-sponsored teams, clubs and organizations by conducting fundraising activities."

This past year, the club did many things. They ran the sports snack bars, provided chaperones for homecoming, sponsored the 50/50 raffles at games, sponsored the B.J. Thompson Model Ram Award to honor the outstanding female and male student athletes of the year, sold Spiritwear and had another successful mulch sale in the Spring. These, and other fundraising efforts netted a profit to be contributed to the school to support a wide range of programs.

The RHS Booster Club President, Ann English, presented a total of \$32,500 to the school. \$20,000 was given to Athletics, \$5000 was given to Principal Dr. Munk for School Based Organizations and Clubs, \$4500 was given to support the RHS Marching Band, \$2000 was given to the RHS After Prom Party fund and \$1000 was given to the Journalism Academy. The Booster Club votes on its budget in the Fall and spends the academic year raising funds to meet the fundraising targets so that, by the end of June, there is money to distribute.
